**131** children, teens and adults with developmental disabilities and autism participated in 129 online classes

**118** people opened up their homes to one or more people with developmental disabilities to live with them and receive services from Pathlight

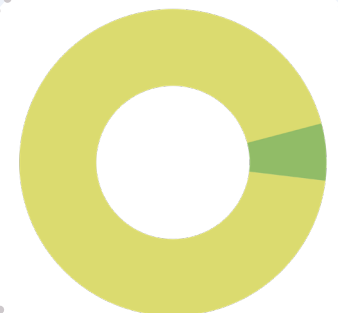
